## ~Job and Volunteer Opportunities at the Parent and Preschool Center (call Chris Stahl 717-397-5717)

1) A staff person is needed for Connection Childcare on Tuesday mornings. This is a 30 week commitment and is a paid position. Hours are from 8:45-11:15 am. You would be working with toddlers and/or infants, assisted by adult volunteers.
