We need individuals, couples, and families to host French students (ages 14-17) as they study English and learn about American culture. Two groups are coming: the first group’s session is July 14 - August 2, and a second group will be here from August 5 – August 24. The programs are directed by Jeff and Ellyn Nolt and sponsored by American Home Life.

If you are interested, here’s what you should know: Hosts receive an up-front stipend of \$440 per 3-week session. In addition, we ask hosts to accommodate two students per home, provide 3 meals a day, and arrange transportation to and from weekday ESL classes.
