- Please bring your lawn chairs as we are encouraging everyone to eat outside under the backyard tree. If going outside is a hardship, then you may use the tables in the fellowship hall.

- We will plan to meet in the sanctuary where the "sound system" will be helpful and a "cooler" environment.

## ~CDC Guidelines for Witmer Heights/First Deaf:

Please respect that time and energy have been put into thoughtful and difficult discussion on guidelines for our church congregation.

After reviewing the CDC guidelines and more discussion with the Board and Elder Team please see the guidelines below for the Witmer Heights congregation.

Those who are vaccinated (and children under 12) may go without masks inside and outside on church property. Be aware of personal space. Certainly, you are always welcome to wear a mask if you are more comfortable.

Those who are not vaccinated, it is recommend that masks continue indoors and social distancing is practiced.

We will continue on with these items:

Hand sanitizer and masks stations at each entry way.

Limit bathroom use to 2 persons at a time.

Sitting every other row in the sanctuary and use the open fellowship hall for social distancing.

Facebook Live video of church services.

Holding off on coffee hour before SS.

Please have a mask readily available when needed. (such as the indoor fellowship meals food line as you read above).

In the past we may have attended church with a cold, sore throat, or headache etc. Please choose to stay home if you have any of these symptons.

Unfortunately, the COVID pandemic is not over and it is fluid. The guidelines may change again at a later date. (Hopefully towards the positive!) Some persons continue to be wary of COVID and we want to respect each other.
